On April 25th, 2010, New Garden Friends School will launch a new Arts and Entertainment series for the Greater Greensboro Community. The series, "Many Friends, Many Voices" is designed to heighten awareness of Greensboro's diverse and vibrant arts community. The first event, "Celebrating the Music of Greensboro" will be held in the historic Carolina Theatre, one of Greensboro's most revered downtown landmarks.

Diversity, service to the community and inclusivity are fundamental values held by the school. These arts events will serve as an opportunity for the school to celebrate these values with the greater Greensboro community and to heighten the community's understanding of our commitment to exemplify diversity and inclusiveness in our educational philosophy, our curriculum and our practices.

We are honored to have Joan Garry as our keynote speaker. One of America's most vocal, passionate and effective civil rights leaders, Ms. Garry has a special affinity for New Garden Friends School and the innovative education we provide.

About Joan Garry



Joan began her career as part of the management team responsible for the launch of MTV in 1981 and it is that experience that shaped her view that the media has a profound influence on the attitudes and

opinions of people on nearly every issue.

After fourteen years in the entertainment business, holding a variety of executive positions in strategic planning and new business development, Joan set her sights on the nonprofit sector. With her 1997 appointment as executive director of GLAAD, one of the nation's largest gay rights organizations, Joan found an opportunity to bring together her expertise, her skills and her powerful voice. Before she knew it, she was debating Jerry Falwell and Bill O'Reilly on issues that mean something to her family and to families across America.

Joan plays a critical role as a visible media spokesperson and critic. In 1999, Entertainment Weekly featured her on its list of the 100 Most Influential People in Entertainment. Joan's articulate advocacy has been featured across all national news networks

including NBC's Today, ABC's World News Tonight and The News Hour with Jim Lehrer. Joan has also appeared on an array of news channels including CNN, MSNBC and Fox News. Her comments are frequently sought by leading newspapers including The New York Times, The Washington Post, Newsweek and The Wall Street Journal. Her thought-provoking editorials have appeared in outlets such as Time and USA Today.

Joan is currently a professor at The Annenberg School for Communications at the University of Pennsylvania. She is also a featured blogger for The Huffington Post and a regular contributor to The Newark Star Ledger where she writes about parenting and politics. Joan hails from Long Island but her parents lived here in Greensboro for nearly thirty years. Joan makes her home today in New Jersey with her partner of 28 years and their three children. Joan's landmark 1993 court challenge to New Jersey's second-parent adoption law made her the first lesbian in that state to adopt her partner's biological children.

In the spirit of using her voice to advocate for change, in 2005 Joan became the first female singing member of the New York City Gay Men's Chorus.
