HOW DOES SUMMER WORK?

Year round students are automatically enrolled in our Summer Camp program.

When does Summer Camp start and end?

One week after school lets out in June and one week before school starts in August. During the gap weeks, Extended Care is available and provided in the cost of Year Round Preschool.

Where is it located?

Preschool Summer Camp and preschool Extended Care are held in the same A Child's Garden classrooms your child is already familiar with.

Who staffs it?

A combination of our school year faculty and summer staff. PreK/TK teacher Jeannie Wigal leads the Summer Camp program.

The Summer Camp ratio is 6:1. The majority of our preschool summer staff have, or are working toward, degrees in early childhood education. All have prior experience working with children and are background checked.

What is the day like?

Year round students won't miss out on the fun, discovery, excitement, and friendship of Summer Camp! They will follow the same schedule with the exception of a 30-minute pull session four times/week with NGFS teacher Cory MacKenzie. Cory currently works with the Transitional Kindergarten class on skills needed to be at school and will create developmentally appropriate activities for the children enrolled in year round preschool.

What are the hours?

The classroom doors open at 8 a.m. with Summer Camp activities beginning at 9 a.m. Camp is over at 3:30 and Extended Care is available until 6 p.m.
