### Arrive 8-8:25 a.m.

- Turn into the main entrance.
- Make a right turn to loop around in front of building A.

### Dismissal

Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri. - 3:30 p.m.; Wed 3:00 p.m.

- Turn into the main entrance.
- Form 2 car lanes upon entering so no cars are stopped on Pleasant Ridge Road.
- Take turns forming a single line when approaching the front of the school.
- Pull your vehicle as far forward as you can each time; please don't stop in front of the covered area if there is room to pull forward.
- Exit out the main entrance. Watch for cars from Upper School using the same exit.

For a replacement key card, there is a fee of \$5.
