Dear Upper School Students and Families,

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

- At arrival, turn into the <u>first school entrance coming from Old Oak Ridge Rd</u>. Always enter and never exit! Student drivers use this entrance as well.
- Make a right turn to pull in front of building B. Form 1 car line upon entering.
- At dismissal, all Upper School family drivers and student drivers must exit out the main entrance. Watch for Middle School traffic merging to exit as well.
