COMMUNICATION

Email - We send email messages, such as this one, via Renweb (our school information system). These emails will come from various NGFS addresses, such as news@ngfs.org, and from individual staff members, such as dallman@ngfs.org.

NGFS App - Directions for the App are available on the Back to School webpage. The NGFS App is used to "house" Resources, which are located on the home screen. App notifications are used to send reminders and time-sensitive updates. The calendar (located at the bottom of the App home screen) is an especially useful feature (see example below; click the image to see an enlarged version). I encourage you to start using the NGFS App now.
