- Understanding the New FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for families of current juniors and seniors, with guest speaker from the College Foundation of North Carolina and Allie Blosser, NGFS Upper School Academic Dean and College Counselor
- NCSEAA Opportunity Scholarship expanded opportunities for 2024 for families of K-12 students, with Pattie Midgett, NGFS Director of Enrollment Management, and Michael Hill, NGFS Finance Office
- NCSEAA ESA+ Program (North Carolina's program to meet the financial needs of K-12 students with disabilities) with Marci Richardson, NGFS Learning Specialist

Transition meetings provide an opportunity for parents/guardians to learn about and ask questions about the next grade level.
