### 3. Connections and Advocacy

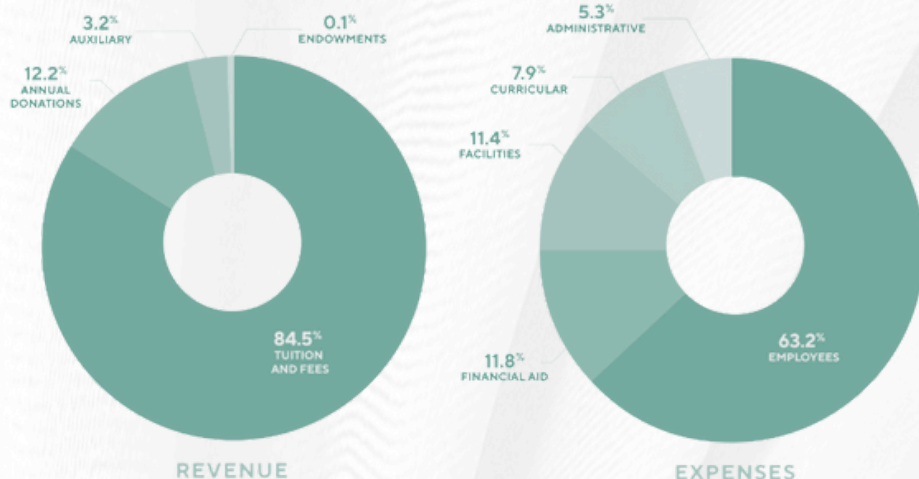
